Over time, she heard God's call to do something about it, and – after much discernment – she followed the call.

Since 2012, The Lift has been creating more secure lives for low-income Minnesotans through low-cost repairs, free pre-purchase inspections of used cars, and connections to other community partners to help meet customers' holistic needs.
